

# The Advance to Zero framework for ending homelessness



## A shared strategy

To prevent, reduce and end homelessness, starting with rough sleeping in local communities, by demonstrating that when any future incidents of homelessness do occur, they are rare, brief and once-off – measured by seeking to reach and sustain functional zero.

## Four interconnected approaches to ending homelessness

Housing First - Systems change

Person-centered and driven by lived experience

Improvement and data-driven

Place-based collaboration
